Applicants

- Learners who are currently in grade 12
- Students who are registering for the first year
- Students who are already registered with a recognised South African public university (under- or postgraduate study)
- Education details
- Average of 65% (all applicants)
- University entrance criteria for degree studies met

Applicants who did not study towards a degree after matriculating will be considered only if they matriculated in 2013 (a minimum of two years before the year to be funded)

Institutions

- ❖ South African public universities registered with the Council of Higher Education
- ❖ Universities of technology for IT and property-related qualifications

Our bursary application process:

1



Apply for bursary

You can fax, post, hand-deliver or email your application to us, or you can apply online at nedbank.co.za/bursaries.

2

Notification of receipt of application

You will receive notification that your application has been received and that it is under review.



3

Shortlisting

We will compile a shortlist of applicants using our screening and selection criteria, which (as well as the minimum requirements) apply to everyone no matter which mode of application is used.

4

Means test

All shortlisted applicants undergo a means test aimed at assessment of financial affordability.



5

Interviews

Applicants who meet our requirements according to the means test will be invited for an interview with a relevant Nedbank staffmember.



7

Bursary offer

Based on integrated feedback, an offer will be made to a successful bursary applicant. However, this is a preliminary offer. The final offer depends on final grade 12 results, plus proof of acceptance for an undergraduate degree at a registered university of the Council of Higher Education or a qualification at a university of technology. Bursaries will be offered at the sole discretion of Nedbank and any decision to not award a bursary will be final.

Call for assessments

All applicants shortlisted after the interviews will be asked to come for an assessment. These assessments take place at our main offices in Johannesburg, Durban and Cape Town.
